FRONT LOAD



For nearly 40 years, Bucks Fabricating has been manufacturing containers for a variety of industries. In April 1984, the business began with a 4,000 sq ft shop, manufacturing small cans and pallets. Shortly after, we expanded to offering roll-off containers. In 1993, the company began manufacturing specialty containers and expanded its building footprint. It continued to grow, adding paint operations, additional equipment, product lines, and rolled out national marketing initiatives. All of which allowed us to expand our facility in 2019 when we started operating within a 96,000 sq ft area for manufacturing and stocking our products. For a while, Bucks Fabricating put a hold on manufacturing small cans. However, when Bucks Fabricating expanded their footprint, they knew it was time to reintroduce the Bucks Fabricating small can back into the market. Bucks Fabricating prides themselves on being a one-stop-shop for containers. Their WorkForce™ line of products does just that, especially since adding the small can, which Bucks Fabricating named the Trash Box™.

While some small can and roll-off manufacturers may only offer a single small can solution, Bucks Fabricating offers both front and rear load designs. Let's talk more about a front load small can.

Front load containers are used in conjunction with front-end loader garbage trucks. These trucks are equipped with forks on the front of the truck that are used to pick up the front loader by the side fork pockets. Then, the hydraulics of the truck lift the container above the cab to be dumped into the container, or hopper. Available in sizes ranging from 2 to 8 yards, front load small cans are manufactured in both slant and flat lid designs, some even available with side doors. The plastic lid design features a six-knuckle hinge line that has a 30% greater thickness than other standard style lids and allows for little to no water retention. The 3/4" drain hole and plastic plug provides a simple and efficient way to empty out any unwanted liquids, such as rain that may fill up in the container and add unnecessary weight. The fork pockets are manufactured with formed 7GA steel and welded 18" from the bottom of the container to ensure that the forks on the trucks can easily pick it up and dump the contents. Before the Trash Box™ is primed and painted, Bucks Fabricating has a prep team that scrapes, cleans, and inspects the container, ensuring a smooth and long-lasting finish.
